## **RESOLUTION**

Authorizing and directing the Committee on the Judiciary to inquire whether the House should impeach G. Thomas Porteous, a judge of the United States District Court for the Eastern District of Louisiana.

- 1 Resolved, That in continuance of the authority con-
- 2 ferred in House Resolution 1448 of the One Hundred
- 3 Tenth Congress adopted by the House of Representatives
- 4 on September 17, 2008, the Committee on the Judiciary
- 5 shall inquire whether the House should impeach G. Thom-
- 6 as Porteous, a judge of the United States District Court
- 7 for the Eastern District of Louisiana.

- 1 Sec. 2. The Committee on the Judiciary or any sub-
- 2 committee or task force designated by the Committee may,
- 3 in connection with the inquiry under this resolution, take
- 4 affidavits and depositions by a member, counsel, or con-
- 5 sultant of the Committee, pursuant to notice or subpoena.
- 6 Sec. 3. There shall be paid out of the applicable ac-
- 7 counts of the House such sums as may be necessary to
- 8 assist the Committee on the Judiciary in conducting the
- 9 inquiry under this resolution, any of which may be used
- 10 for the procurement of staff or consultant services.
- 11 Sec. 4. (a) For the purpose of the inquiry under this
- 12 resolution, the Committee on the Judiciary is authorized
- 13 to require by subpoena or otherwise—
- 14 (1) the attendance and testimony of any person (in-
- 15 cluding at a taking of a deposition by counsel or consult-
- 16 ant of the Committee); and
- 17 (2) the production of such things;
- 18 as it deems necessary to such inquiry.
- 19 (b) The Chairman of the Committee on the Judiciary,
- 20 after consultation with the ranking member, may exercise
- 21 the authority of the Committee under subsection (a).
- (c) The Committee on the Judiciary may adopt a rule
- 23 regulating the taking of depositions by a member, counsel,

- 1 or consultant of the Committee, including pursuant to
- 2 subpoena.
