# RESOLUTION

Amending the Rules of the House of Representatives to require that general appropriations for military construction and veterans' affairs be considered as stand-alone measures.

1       *Resolved*, That rule XXI of the Rules of the House  
2 of Representatives is amended by adding at the end the  
3 following new clause:

4       **“Stand-alone requirement for military construction**  
5                       **and veterans' affairs appropriations**

6       “11. It shall not be in order to consider any bill or  
7 joint resolution, or conference report thereon, containing  
8 appropriations within the jurisdiction of the Subcommittee

1 on Military Construction, Veterans Affairs, and Related  
2 Agencies of the Committee on Appropriations if such  
3 measure also contains appropriations within the jurisdic-  
4 tion of any other subcommittee of that committee. The  
5 preceding sentence shall not apply to any measure making  
6 supplemental appropriations or to any measure continuing  
7 appropriations for a period of not to exceed 60 days.”.
