RESOLUTION

Providing for consideration of the Senate amendments to the bill (H.R. 1388) to reauthorize and reform the national service laws.

1 *Resolved*, That upon adoption of this resolution it
2 shall be in order to take from the Speaker's table the bill
3 (H.R. 1388) to reauthorize and reform the national serv-
4 ice laws, with the Senate amendments thereto, and to con-
5 sider in the House, without intervention of any point of
6 order except those arising under clause 10 of rule XXI,
7 a single motion offered by the chair of the Committee on

1 Education and Labor or his designee that the House con-
2 cur in the Senate amendments. The Senate amendments
3 and the motion shall be considered as read. The motion
4 shall be debatable for one hour equally divided and con-
5 trolled by the chair and ranking minority member of the
6 Committee on Education and Labor. The previous ques-
7 tion shall be considered as ordered on the motion to final
8 adoption without intervening motion or demand for divi-
9 sion of the question.
