## RESOLUTION

Providing for consideration of the bill (H.R. 2454) to create clean energy jobs, achieve energy independence, reduce global warming pollution and transition to a clean energy economy.

1       *Resolved*, That upon the adoption of this resolution  
2 it shall be in order to consider in the House the bill (H.R.  
3 2454) to create clean energy jobs, achieve energy inde-  
4 pendence, reduce global warming pollution and transition  
5 to a clean energy economy. All points of order against con-  
6 sideration of the bill are waived except those arising under

1 clause 9 or 10 of rule XXI. In lieu of the amendment rec-  
2 ommended by the Committee on Energy and Commerce  
3 now printed in the bill, an amendment in the nature of  
4 a substitute consisting of the text of H.R. 2998, modified  
5 by the amendment printed in part A of the report of the  
6 Committee on Rules accompanying this resolution, shall  
7 be considered as adopted. The bill, as amended, shall be  
8 considered as read. All points of order against provisions  
9 of the bill, as amended, are waived. The previous question  
10 shall be considered as ordered on the bill, as amended,  
11 and on any further amendment thereto, to final passage  
12 without intervening motion except: (1) three hours of de-  
13 bate, with two and one half hours equally divided and con-  
14 trolled by the chair and ranking minority member of the  
15 Committee on Energy and Commerce and 30 minutes  
16 equally divided and controlled by the chair and ranking  
17 minority member of the Committee on Ways and Means;  
18 (2) the further amendment in the nature of a substitute  
19 printed in part B of the report of the Committee on Rules,  
20 if offered by Representative Forbes of Virginia or his des-  
21 ignee, which shall be in order without intervention of any  
22 point of order except those arising under clause 9 or 10  
23 of rule XXI, shall be considered as read, and shall be sepa-  
24 rately debatable for 30 minutes equally divided and con-

- 1 trolled by the proponent and an opponent; and (3) one
- 2 motion to recommit with or without instructions.
