RESOLUTION

Providing for consideration of the bill (H.R. 2965) to amend the Small Business Act with respect to the Small Business Innovation Research Program and the Small Business Technology Transfer Program, and for other purposes.

- 1 Resolved, That at any time after the adoption of this
- 2 resolution the Speaker may, pursuant to clause 2(b) of
- 3 rule XVIII, declare the House resolved into the Committee
- 4 of the Whole House on the state of the Union for consider-

ation of the bill (H.R. 2965) to amend the Small Business Act with respect to the Small Business Innovation Re-3 search Program and the Small Business Technology 4 Transfer Program, and for other purposes. The first reading of the bill shall be dispensed with. All points of order 6 against consideration of the bill are waived except those arising under clause 9 or 10 of rule XXI. General debate 8 shall be confined to the bill and shall not exceed one hour, with 40 minutes equally divided and controlled by the 10 chair and ranking minority member of the Committee on Small Business and 20 minutes equally divided and con-11 12 trolled by the chair and ranking minority member of the Committee on Science and Technology. After general debate the bill shall be considered for amendment under the 14 15 five-minute rule. In lieu of the amendment recommended by the Committee on Science and Technology now printed in the bill, it shall be in order to consider as an original bill for the purpose of amendment under the five-minute 18 rule the amendment in the nature of a substitute rec-19 ommended by the Committee on Small Business now 20 21 printed in the bill. The committee amendment in the nature of a substitute shall be considered as read. All points 23 of order against the committee amendment in the nature of a substitute are waived except those arising under clause 10 of rule XXI. Notwithstanding clause 11 of rule

- 1 XVIII, no amendment to the committee amendment in the
- 2 nature of a substitute shall be in order except those print-
- 3 ed in the report of the Committee on Rules accompanying
- 4 this resolution. Each such amendment may be offered only
- 5 in the order printed in the report, may be offered only
- 6 by a Member designated in the report, shall be considered
- 7 as read, shall be debatable for the time specified in the
- 8 report equally divided and controlled by the proponent and
- 9 an opponent, shall not be subject to amendment, and shall
- 10 not be subject to a demand for division of the question
- 11 in the House or in the Committee of the Whole. The pro-
- 12 ponent of any such amendment may modify its amend-
- 13 atory instructions before the question is put thereon. All
- 14 points of order against such amendments are waived ex-
- 15 cept those arising under clause 9 or 10 of rule XXI. At
- 16 the conclusion of consideration of the bill for amendment
- 17 the Committee shall rise and report the bill to the House
- 18 with such amendments as may have been adopted. The
- 19 previous question shall be considered as ordered on the
- 20 bill and amendments thereto to final passage without in-
- 21 tervening motion except one motion to recommit with or
- 22 without instructions.
- SEC. 2. The Chair may entertain a motion that the
- 24 Committee rise only if offered by the chair of the Com-
- 25 mittee on Small Business or her designee. The Chair may

- 1 not entertain a motion to strike out the enacting words
- 2 of the bill (as described in clause 9 of rule XVIII).
- 3 Sec. 3. During consideration of H.R. 2965, the Chair
- 4 may reduce to two minutes the minimum time for elec-
- 5 tronic voting under clause 6 of rule XVIII and clauses 8
- 6 and 9 of rule XX.
