Ms. PINGREE of Maine, from the Committee on Rules, reported the following resolution; which was referred to the House Calendar and ordered to be printed

RESOLUTION

Providing for consideration of the bill (H.R. 3326) making appropriations for the Department of Defense for the fiscal year ending September 30, 2010, and for other purposes.

1 *Resolved*, That at any time after the adoption of this
2 resolution the Speaker may, pursuant to clause 2(b) of
3 rule XVIII, declare the House resolved into the Committee
4 of the Whole House on the state of the Union for consider-
5 ation of the bill (H.R. 3326) making appropriations for

1 the Department of Defense for the fiscal year ending Sep-
2 tember 30, 2010, and for other purposes. The first read-
3 ing of the bill shall be dispensed with. All points of order
4 against consideration of the bill are waived except those
5 arising under clause 9 or 10 of rule XXI. General debate
6 shall be confined to the bill and shall not exceed one hour
7 equally divided and controlled by the chair and ranking
8 minority member of the Committee on Appropriations.
9 After general debate the bill shall be considered for
10 amendment under the five-minute rule. The bill shall be
11 considered as read through page 147, line 4. Points of
12 order against provisions in the bill for failure to comply
13 with clause 2 of rule XXI are waived. Notwithstanding
14 clause 11 of rule XVIII, except as provided in section 2,
15 no amendment shall be in order except: (1) the amend-
16 ments printed in part A of the report of the Committee
17 on Rules accompanying this resolution, which may be of-
18 fered only in the order printed in the report, may be of-
19 fered only by a Member designated in the report, shall
20 be considered as read, shall be debatable for the time spec-
21 ified in the report equally divided and controlled by the
22 proponent and an opponent, and shall not be subject to
23 a demand for division of the question; (2) not to exceed
24 eight of the amendments printed in part B of the report
25 of the Committee on Rules if offered by Representative

1 Flake of Arizona or his designee, which may be offered
2 only in the order printed in the report, shall be considered
3 as read, and shall be debatable for 10 minutes equally di-
4 vided and controlled by the proponent and an opponent;
5 (3) an en bloc amendment, if offered by Rep. Flake of
6 Arizona or his designee, consisting of all of the amend-
7 ments printed in part B of the report of the Committee
8 on Rules, which shall be considered as read, shall be debat-
9 able for 10 minutes equally divided and controlled by the
10 proponent and an opponent, and shall not be subject to
11 a demand for division of the question; and (4) not to ex-
12 ceed two of the amendments printed in part C of the re-
13 port of the Committee on Rules if offered by Representa-
14 tive Campbell of California or his designee, which may be
15 offered only in the order printed in the report, shall be
16 considered as read, and shall be debatable for 10 minutes
17 equally divided and controlled by the proponent and an
18 opponent. All points of order against such amendments
19 are waived except those arising under clause 9 or 10 of
20 rule XXI. At the conclusion of consideration of the bill
21 for amendment the Committee shall rise and report the
22 bill to the House with such amendments as may have been
23 adopted. In the case of sundry amendments reported from
24 the Committee, the question of their adoption shall be put
25 to the House en gros and without division of the question.

1 The previous question shall be considered as ordered on
2 the bill and amendments thereto to final passage without
3 intervening motion except one motion to recommit with
4 or without instructions.

5 SEC. 2. After disposition of the amendments specified
6 in the first section of this resolution, the chair and ranking
7 minority member of the Committee on Appropriations or
8 their designees each may offer one pro forma amendment
9 to the bill for the purpose of debate, which shall be con-
10 trolled by the proponent.

11 SEC. 3. The Chair may entertain a motion that the
12 Committee rise only if offered by the chair of the Com-
13 mittee on Appropriations or his designee. The Chair may
14 not entertain a motion to strike out the enacting words
15 of the bill (as described in clause 9 of rule XVIII).

16 SEC. 4. During consideration of H.R. 3326, the Chair
17 may reduce to two minutes the minimum time for elec-
18 tronic voting under clause 6 of rule XVIII and clauses 8
19 and 9 of rule XX.
