Ms. PINGREE of Maine, from the Committee on Rules, reported the following resolution; which was referred to the House Calendar and ordered to be printed

RESOLUTION

Providing for consideration of the Senate amendment to the bill (H.R. 3326) making appropriations for the Department of Defense for the fiscal year ending September 30, 2010, and for other purposes; for consideration of the joint resolution (H.J. Res. 64) making further continuing appropriations for fiscal year 2010, and for other

purposes; for consideration of the bill (H.R. 4314) to permit continued financing of Government operations; for consideration of the Senate amendment to the bill (H.R. 2847) making appropriations for the Departments of Commerce and Justice, and Science, and Related Agencies for the fiscal year ending September 30, 2010, and for other purposes; and for other purposes.

1 *Resolved*, That upon adoption of this resolution it
2 shall be in order to take from the Speaker's table the bill
3 (H.R. 3326) making appropriations for the Department
4 of Defense for the fiscal year ending September 30, 2010,
5 and for other purposes, with the Senate amendment there-
6 to, and to consider in the House, without intervention of
7 any point of order except those arising under clause 10
8 of rule XXI, a motion offered by the chair of the Com-
9 mittee on Appropriations or his designee that the House
10 concur in the Senate amendment with the amendment
11 printed in part A of the report of the Committee on Rules
12 accompanying this resolution. The Senate amendment and
13 the motion shall be considered as read. The motion shall
14 be debatable for one hour equally divided and controlled
15 by the chair and ranking minority member of the Com-
16 mittee on Appropriations. The previous question shall be
17 considered as ordered on the motion to its adoption with-
18 out intervening motion.

19 SEC. 2. Upon the adoption of this resolution it shall
20 be in order to consider in the House the joint resolution

1 (H.J. Res. 64) making further continuing appropriations
2 for fiscal year 2010, and for other purposes. All points
3 of order against consideration of the joint resolution are
4 waived except those arising under clause 9 or 10 of rule
5 XXI. The joint resolution shall be considered as read. All
6 points of order against provisions in the joint resolution
7 are waived. The previous question shall be considered as
8 ordered on the joint resolution to final passage without
9 intervening motion except: (1) one hour of debate equally
10 divided and controlled by the chair and ranking minority
11 member of the Committee on Appropriations; and (2) one
12 motion to recommit.

13 SEC. 3. Upon the adoption of this resolution it shall
14 be in order to consider in the House the bill (H.R. 4314)
15 to permit continued financing of Government operations.
16 All points of order against consideration of the bill are
17 waived except those arising under clause 9 or 10 of rule
18 XXI. The bill shall be considered as read. All points of
19 order against provisions in the bill are waived. The pre-
20 vious question shall be considered as ordered on the bill
21 to final passage without intervening motion except: (1) one
22 hour of debate equally divided and controlled by the chair
23 and ranking minority member of the Committee on Ways
24 and Means; and (2) one motion to recommit.

1 SEC. 4. Upon the adoption of this resolution it shall
2 be in order to take from the Speaker's table the bill (H.R.
3 2847) making appropriations for the Departments of
4 Commerce and Justice, and Science, and Related Agencies
5 for the fiscal year ending September 30, 2010, and for
6 other purposes, with the Senate amendment thereto, and
7 to consider in the House, without intervention of any point
8 of order except those arising under clause 10 of rule XXI,
9 a motion offered by the chair of the Committee on Appro-
10 priations or his designee that the House concur in the
11 Senate amendment with the amendment printed in part
12 B of the report of the Committee on Rules. The Senate
13 amendment and the motion shall be considered as read.
14 The motion shall be debatable for one hour equally divided
15 and controlled by the chair and ranking minority member
16 of the Committee on Appropriations. The previous ques-
17 tion shall be considered as ordered on the motion to its
18 adoption without intervening motion.

19 SEC. 5. In the engrossment of the House amendment
20 to the Senate amendment to H.R. 2847, the Clerk shall—

21 (a) add the text of H.R. 2920, as passed by the
22 House, as new matter at the end of the text proposed to
23 be inserted by the House amendment;

1 (b) assign appropriate designations to provisions
2 within the engrossment of the text proposed to be inserted
3 by the House; and

4 (c) conform provisions for short titles within the en-
5 grossment of the text proposed to be inserted by the
6 House.

7 SEC. 6. It shall be in order at any time during the
8 remainder of the first session of the One Hundred Elev-
9 enth Congress for the Speaker to entertain motions that
10 the House suspend the rules. The Speaker or her designee
11 shall consult with the Minority Leader or his designee on
12 the selection of any matter for consideration pursuant to
13 this section.

14 SEC. 7. The requirement of clause 6(a) of rule XIII
15 for a two-thirds vote to consider a report from the Com-
16 mittee on Rules on the same day it is presented to the
17 House is waived for the remainder of the first session of
18 the One Hundred Eleventh Congress.

19 SEC. 8. The chair of the Committee on Appropria-
20 tions may insert in the Congressional Record at any time
21 during the remainder of the first session of the One Hun-
22 dred Eleventh Congress such material as he may deem ex-
23 planatory of the Senate amendments and the motions
24 specified in the first and fourth sections of this resolution.

1 SEC. 9. On any legislative day of the second session
2 of the One Hundred Eleventh Congress before January
3 12, 2010, the Speaker at any time may dispense with or-
4 ganizational or legislative business.

5 SEC. 10. On any legislative day of the second session
6 of the One Hundred Eleventh Congress before January
7 12, 2010, the Chair at any time may declare the House
8 adjourned or declare the House adjourned pursuant to an
9 applicable concurrent resolution of adjournment.

10 SEC. 11. (a) On any legislative day of the first session
11 of the One Hundred Eleventh Congress, the Speaker may
12 at any time declare the House adjourned.

13 (b) When the House adjourns on a motion pursuant
14 to this subsection or a declaration pursuant to subsection
15 (a) on the legislative day of:

16 (1) Wednesday, December 16, 2009, it shall
17 stand adjourned until 6 p.m. on Saturday, December
18 19, 2009.

19 (2) Saturday, December 19, 2009, it shall
20 stand adjourned until noon on Wednesday, Decem-
21 ber 23, 2009.

22 (3) Wednesday, December 23, 2009, it shall
23 stand adjourned until 10 a.m. on Saturday, Decem-
24 ber 26, 2009.

1 (4) Saturday, December 26, 2009, it shall
2 stand adjourned until noon on Wednesday, Decem-
3 ber 30, 2009.

4 (5) Wednesday, December 30, 2009, it shall
5 stand adjourned until 10 a.m. on Saturday, January
6 2, 2010.

7 (c) If, during any adjournment addressed by sub-
8 section (b), the House has received: (1) confirmation that
9 the President has approved H.R. 3326; (2) a message
10 from the Senate transmitting its passage without amend-
11 ment of H.R. 4314; and (3) a message from the Senate
12 transmitting its concurrence in an applicable concurrent
13 resolution of adjournment, the House shall stand ad-
14 journed pursuant to such concurrent resolution of ad-
15 journment.

16 (d) The Speaker may appoint Members to perform
17 the duties of the Chair for the duration of the period ad-
18 dressed by this section as though under clause 8(a) of rule
19 I.
