1 SECTION 1. SHORT TITLE.

2 This Act may be cited as the "Longfellow House-3 Washington's Headquarters National Historic Site Des-4 ignation Act".

5 SEC. 2. REDESIGNATION OF LONGFELLOW NATIONAL HIS6 TORIC SITE, MASSACHUSETTS.

7 (a) IN GENERAL.—The Longfellow National Historic
8 Site in Cambridge, Massachusetts, shall be known and
9 designated as "Longfellow House-Washington's Head10 quarters National Historic Site".

(b) REFERENCES.—Any reference in a law, map, regulation, document, paper, or other record of the United
States to the Longfellow National Historic Site shall be
considered to be a reference to the "Longfellow HouseWashington's Headquarters National Historic Site".
