## A BILL

To extend the temporary suspension of duty on certain AC electric motors of an output exceeding 74.6 W but not exceeding 105 W.

1       *Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representa-*  
2       *tives of the United States of America in Congress assembled,*

3       **SECTION 1. CERTAIN AC ELECTRIC MOTORS OF AN OUT-**  
4                               **PUT EXCEEDING 74.6 W BUT NOT EXCEEDING**  
5                               **105 W.**

6       (a) IN GENERAL.—Heading 9902.85.07 of the Har-  
7       monized Tariff Schedule of the United States (relating to  
8       certain AC electric motors of an output exceeding 74.6  
9       W but not exceeding 105 W) is amended—

1           (1) by striking “12/31/2009” and inserting  
2           “12/31/2011”; and

3           (2) by striking “free” and inserting “1%”.

4           (b) EFFECTIVE DATE.—The amendment made by  
5 subsection (a) applies to goods entered, or withdrawn from  
6 warehouse for consumption, on or after the 15th day after  
7 the date of the enactment of this Act.
