3 **SECTION 1. ION EXCHANGE RESIN, POLYSTYRENE**
4 **CROSSLINKED WITH DIVINYLBENZENE,**
5 **CHLOROMETHYLATED,**
6 **TRIMETHYLAMMONIUM SALT.**

7 (a) IN GENERAL.—Subchapter II of chapter 99 of
8 the Harmonized Tariff Schedule of the United States is
9 amended by inserting in numerical sequence the following
10 new heading:

“	9902.01.00	Ion exchange resin, polystyrene crosslinked with divinylbenzene, chloromethylated, trimethylammonium salt (CAS No. 69011-19-4) (provided for in subheading 3914.00.60)	Free	No change	No change	On or before 12/31/2011	”.

1 (b) **EFFECTIVE DATE.**—The amendment made by
2 subsection (a) applies to goods entered, or withdrawn from
3 warehouse for consumption, on or after the 15th day after
