Mrs. FEINSTEIN introduced the following bill; which was read twice and referred to the Committee on Finance

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## A BILL

To extend the temporary reduction of duty on artichokes, prepared or preserved otherwise than by vinegar or acetic acid, not frozen.

1 *Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representa-*  
2 *tives of the United States of America in Congress assembled,*

3 **SECTION 1. ARTICHOKES, PREPARED OR PRESERVED OTH-**  
4 **ERWISE THAN BY VINEGAR OR ACETIC ACID,**  
5 **NOT FROZEN.**

6 (a) IN GENERAL.—Heading 9902.03.89 of the Har-  
7 monized Tariff Schedule of the United States (relating to  
8 certain artichokes) is amended—

9 (1) by striking “13.8%” and inserting  
10 “13.34%”; and

1           (2) by striking “12/31/2009” and inserting  
2           “12/31/2011”.

3           (b) **EFFECTIVE DATE.**—The amendment made by  
4 subsection (a) applies with respect to goods entered, or  
5 withdrawn from warehouse for consumption, on or after  
6 the 15th day after the date of the enactment of this Act.

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
