1 *Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representa-*
2 *tives of the United States of America in Congress assembled,*

3 **SECTION 1. SODIUM PETROLEUM SULFONIC ACIDS, SO-**
4 **DIUM SALTS.**

5 (a) IN GENERAL.—Heading 9902.34.01 of the Har-
6 monized Tariff Schedule of the United States (relating to
7 sodium petroleum sulfonic acids, sodium salts) is amended
8 by striking “12/31/2009” and inserting “12/31/2011”.

9 (b) EFFECTIVE DATE.—The amendment made by
10 subsection (a) applies to goods entered, or withdrawn from

- 1 warehouse for consumption, on or after the 15th day after
- 2 the date of the enactment of this Act.
