3 SECTION 1. SHORT TITLE.

4 This Act may be cited as the "Strengthening and Up5 dating Resources and Equipment Act" or the "SURE
6 Act".

1	SEC. 2. CLARIFICATION ON USE OF FUNDS RELATING TO
2	CERTAIN HOMELAND SECURITY GRANTS.
3	(a) IN GENERAL.—Section 2008 of the Homeland
4	Security Act of 2002 (6 U.S.C. 609) is amended—
5	(1) in subsection $(a)(4)$, by inserting before the
6	semicolon at the end the following: ", and any re-
7	lated maintenance agreements, user fees, or
8	sustainment costs"; and
9	(2) in subsection (b)(3), by adding at the end
10	the following:
11	"(C) Equipment maintenance.—With
12	respect to the use of amounts awarded to a
13	grant recipient under section 2003 or 2004 for
14	equipment purchase and maintenance costs, the
15	Administrator may not—
16	"(i) impose a limit on the amount of
17	any such award that may be used to pay
18	for such purchase and maintenance costs,
19	including any costs referred to in sub-
20	section $(a)(4)$; or
21	"(ii) impose any additional limitation,
22	including any fiscal year limitation, beyond
23	any limitation under this section, on the
24	amount of any such award that may be
25	used for a specific type, purpose, or cat-

egory of equipment purchase or mainte nance cost.".

3 (b) EFFECTIVE DATE.—The amendments made by
4 subsection (a) shall take effect on the date of the enact5 ment of this section and shall apply to grants made under
6 section 2003 or 2004 of the Homeland Security Act of
7 2002 (6 U.S.C. 604 and 605), in accordance with the pro8 visions specified in section 2008 of such Act (6 U.S.C.
9 609), as amended by subsection (a) of this section, on or
10 after October 1, 2008.
