A BILL

To prevent terrorists and those at war with the United States from receiving the same treatment as United States citizens and to ensure that the trials of those individuals would not bring more harm or reduce national security in the United States.

1 *Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representa-*
2 *tives of the United States of America in Congress assembled,*

3 **SECTION 1. SHORT TITLE.**

4 This Act may be cited as the “Stopping Criminal
5 Trials for Guantanamo Terrorists Act of 2009”.

1 **SEC. 2. FUND UNAVAILABILITY.**

2 No funds may be made available to the Department
3 of Justice from any law shall be used to prosecute a ter-
4 rorist detained as of April 30, 2009, at Naval Station,
5 Guantanamo Bay, Cuba in a criminal court in the conti-
6 nental United States, Alaska, Hawaii, or the District of
7 Columbia.
