3 SECTION 1. SHORT TITLE.

4 This Act may be cited as the "Fire Sprinkler Incen-

5 tive Act of 2010".

6 SEC. 2. CLASSIFICATION OF AUTOMATIC FIRE SPRINKLER 7 SYSTEMS.

8 (a) IN GENERAL.—Subparagraph (B) of section
9 168(e)(3) of the Internal Revenue Code of 1986 (relating
10 to 5-year property) is amended by striking "and" at the

end of clause (vi), by striking the period at the end of
 clause (vii) and inserting ", and", and by adding at the
 end the following:

4 "(viii) any automated fire sprinkler
5 system placed in service after April 11,
6 2003, in a building or structure which was
7 placed in service before such date.".

8 (b) ALTERNATIVE SYSTEM.—The table contained in 9 section 168(g)(3)(B) of the Internal Revenue Code of 10 1986 is amended by inserting after the item relating to 11 subparagraph (B)(vii) the following:

(c) DEFINITION OF AUTOMATIC FIRE SPRINKLER
SYSTEM.—Subsection (i) of section 168 of the Internal
Revenue Code of 1986 is amended by adding at the end
the following new paragraph:

16 "(20) AUTOMATED FIRE SPRINKLER SYSTEM.—
17 The term 'automated fire sprinkler system' means
18 those sprinkler systems classified under one or more
19 of the following publications of the National Fire
20 Protection Association—

21 "(A) NFPA 13, Installation of Sprinkler
22 Systems,

23 "(B) NFPA 13 D, Installation of Sprin24 kler Systems in One and Two Family Dwellings
25 and Manufactured Homes, and

"(C) NFPA 13 R, Installation of Sprinkler
 Systems in Residential Occupancies up to and
 Including Four Stories in Height.".

4 (d) EFFECTIVE DATE.—The amendments made by
5 this section shall apply to property placed in service after
6 April 11, 2003.

7 (e) WAIVER OF LIMITATIONS.—If refund or credit of any overpayment of tax resulting from the amendments 8 9 made by this section is prevented at any time before the close of the 1-year period beginning on the date of the 10 11 enactment of this Act by the operation of any law or rule of law (including res judicata), such refund or credit may 12 13 nevertheless be made or allowed if claim therefor is filed before the close of such period. 14
