## A BILL

To reevaluate and redirect the stimulus.

1 *Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representa-*  
2 *tives of the United States of America in Congress assembled,*

3 **SECTION 1. SHORT TITLE.**

4 This Act may be cited as the “Reevaluate and Redi-  
5 rect the Stimulus Act of 2010”.

6 **SEC. 2. OMB CERTIFICATION.**

7 Not later 15 days after the date of enactment of this  
8 Act, the Director of the Office of Management and Budget  
9 (referred to in this Act as the “Director”) shall provide  
10 to Congress—

11 (1) a list of programs that have unobligated  
12 stimulus funds provided under the American Rein-

1 vestment and Recovery Act of 2009 and the  
2 amounts that are unobligated; and

3 (2) a list of stimulus funds that remain unobli-  
4 gated that the Director recommends be redirected  
5 toward more effective programs to either assist dis-  
6 placed workers or spur job creation in 2010 with a  
7 breakdown of the amounts of unobligated funds that  
8 could be reprogrammed by program.
