A BILL

To reinstate and extend the deadline for commencement of construction of a hydroelectric project involving the American Falls Reservoir.

1 *Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representa-*
2 *tives of the United States of America in Congress assembled,*

1 **SECTION 1. EXTENSION OF TIME FOR FEDERAL ENERGY**
2 **REGULATORY COMMISSION PROJECT IN-**
3 **VOLVING AMERICAN FALLS RESERVOIR.**

4 Notwithstanding the time period specified in section
5 13 of the Federal Power Act (16 U.S.C. 806) that would
6 otherwise apply to the Federal Energy Regulatory Com-
7 mission project numbered 12423, the Federal Energy
8 Regulatory Commission shall, at the request of the li-
9 censee for the project, and after reasonable notice and in
10 accordance with the procedures of the Commission under
11 that section, reinstate the license and extend the time pe-
12 riod during which the licensee is required to commence
13 the construction of project works to the end of the 3-year
14 period beginning on the date of enactment of this Act.
