## A BILL

To clarify the health care provided by the Secretary of Veterans Affairs that constitutes minimum essential coverage.

- 1 Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representa-

1	SECTION 1. CLARIFICATION OF HEALTH CARE PROVIDED
2	BY THE SECRETARY OF VETERANS AFFAIRS
3	THAT CONSTITUTES MINIMUM ESSENTIAL
4	COVERAGE.
5	(a) In General.—Clause (v) of section
6	5000A(f)(1)(A) of the Internal Revenue Code of 1986, as
7	added by section 1501(b) of the Patient Protection and
8	Affordable Care Act, is amended to read as follows:
9	"(v) chapter 17 or 18 of title 38,
10	United States Code, or otherwise under the
11	laws administered by the Secretary of Vet-
12	erans Affairs, of an individual entitled to
13	coverage under such chapter or laws for
14	essential health benefits (as defined by the
15	Secretary for purposes of section 1302(b)
16	of the Patient Protection and Affordable
17	Care Act) insofar as such benefits are
18	available under such chapter or laws; or".
19	(b) Effective Date.—The amendment made by
20	subsection (a) shall take effect as if included in section
21	1501(b) of the Patient Protection and Affordable Care Act
22	and shall be executed immediately after the amendments
23	made by such section 1501(b).
