1 **SECTION 1. SHORT TITLE.**

2 This Act may be cited as the “Sloan Hills Withdrawal
3 Act”.

4 **SEC. 2. WITHDRAWAL OF SLOAN HILLS AREA OF CLARK**
5 **COUNTY, NEVADA.**

6 (a) DEFINITION OF FEDERAL LAND.—In this sec-
7 tion, the term “Federal land” means the land identified
8 as the “Withdrawal Zone” on the map entitled “Sloan
9 Hills Area” and dated ~~May 5, 2010~~ *June 24, 2010*.

10 (b) WITHDRAWAL.—Subject to valid rights in exist-
11 ence on the date of introduction of this Act, the Federal
12 land is withdrawn from all forms of—

13 (1) location, entry, and patent under the mining
14 laws; and

15 (2) disposition under all laws pertaining to min-
16 eral and geothermal leasing or mineral materials.
