To amend part D of title IV of the Social Security Act to repeal a fee imposed by States on certain child support collections.

2 *tives of the United States of America in Congress assembled,*

3 **SECTION 1. SHORT TITLE.**

4 This Act may be cited as the “Elimination of the Sin-
5 gle Parent Tax Act of 2009”.

1 **SEC. 2. REPEAL OF REQUIREMENT THAT STATES IMPOSE**
2 **MANDATORY FEE FOR SUCCESSFUL CHILD**
3 **SUPPORT COLLECTION FOR FAMILY THAT**
4 **HAS NEVER RECEIVED TANF.**

5 Section 454(6)(B) of the Social Security Act (42
6 U.S.C. 654(6)(B)) is amended—

7 (1) by striking “(i)”;

8 (2) by striking clause (ii); and

9 (3) by redesignating subclauses (I) and (II) as
10 clauses (i) and (ii), respectively.
