## A BILL

To amend the Federal Insecticide, Fungicide, and Rodenticide Act to improve the use of certain registered pesticides.

1 *Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representa-*  
2 *tives of the United States of America in Congress assembled,*

3 **SECTION 1. USE OF REGISTERED PESTICIDES.**

4 Section 3(f) of the Federal Insecticide, Fungicide,  
5 and Rodenticide Act (7 U.S.C. 136a(f)) is amended by  
6 adding at the end the following:

7 “(5) USE OF REGISTERED PESTICIDES.—Not-  
8 withstanding any other law, no permit shall be re-  
9 quired for—

1           “(A) the use of a pesticide that is reg-  
2           istered or otherwise authorized for use under  
3           this Act, if that use is in accordance with this  
4           Act; or

5           “(B)(i) the use of a biological control orga-  
6           nism (as defined in section 403 of the Plant  
7           Protection Act (7 U.S.C. 7702)) for the preven-  
8           tion, control, or eradication of a plant pest or  
9           noxious weed, if that use is in accordance with  
10          that Act (7 U.S.C. 7701 et seq.); or

11          “(ii) the conduct of any other plant pest,  
12          noxious weed, or pest control activity under  
13          that Act, if that activity is conducted in accord-  
14          ance with that Act.”.
