## A BILL

To remove preferential treatment for sleeping bags under the Generalized System of Preferences, and for other purposes.

1 *Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representa-*  
2 *tives of the United States of America in Congress assembled,*

3 **SECTION 1. REMOVAL OF PREFERENTIAL TREATMENT FOR**  
4 **CERTAIN TEXTILE ARTICLES.**

5 (a) IN GENERAL.—Notwithstanding any provision of  
6 title V of the Trade Act of 1974 (19 U.S.C. 2461 et seq.;  
7 relating to the Generalized System of Preferences), no tex-  
8 tile article classifiable under subheading 9404.30.80 of the  
9 Harmonized Tariff Schedule of the United States is eligi-

1 ble for duty-free or other preferential treatment under  
2 such title V.

3 (b) APPLICABILITY.—Subsection (a) applies to goods  
4 entered, or withdrawn from warehouse for consumption,  
5 on or after the 15th day after the date of the enactment  
6 of this Act.
