A BILL

1 *Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives of the United States of America in Congress assembled,*

1 SECTION 1. OHKAY OWINGEH PUEBLO LEASING AUTHOR-

2 ITY.

3 (a) AUTHORIZATION FOR 99-YEAR LEASES.—Sub-
4 section (a) of the first section of the Act of August 9,
5 1955 (25 U.S.C. 415(a)), is amended in the second sen-
6 tence by inserting “and lands held in trust for Ohkay
7 Owingeh Pueblo” after “of land on the Devils Lake Sioux
8 Reservation.”.

9 (b) APPLICATION.—The amendment made by sub-
10 section (a) shall apply to any lease entered into or renewed
11 after the date of the enactment of this Act.
