A BILL

To require the Secretary of the Army to operate the Buford Dam/Lake Sidney Lanier Project and the Allatoona Dam and Reservoir Project, and for other purposes.

1 *Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representa-*
2 *tives of the United States of America in Congress assembled,*

3 **SECTION 1. INDUSTRIAL AND MUNICIPAL WATER SUPPLY,**
4 **LAKE SIDNEY LANIER AND LAKE ALLATOONA,**
5 **GEORGIA.**

6 (a) REQUIREMENT OF SECRETARY OF THE ARMY.—
7 Subject to subsection (b), the Secretary of the Army (act-
8 ing through the Chief of Engineers) (referred to in this
9 section as the “Secretary”) shall operate the Buford Dam/

1 Lake Sidney Lanier Project and the Allatoona Dam and
2 Reservoir Project—

3 (1) for the purpose of municipal and industrial
4 water supply; and

5 (2) notwithstanding each limitation described in
6 section 301(d) of the Water Supply Act of 1958 (43
7 U.S.C. 390b(d)), to include storage in each project
8 for water supply.

9 (b) CONDITION.—Subsection (a) shall not apply un-
10 less the non-Federal sponsor of the water supply storage
11 described in subsection (a) pays the cost for the capital
12 investment for reallocated storage space in accordance
13 with each procedure that the Secretary determines to be
14 necessary.

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
