Mrs. FEINSTEIN introduced the following bill; which was read twice and referred to the Committee on the Judiciary

A BILL

For the relief of Shing Ma “Steve” Li.

1 *Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representa-*
2 *tives of the United States of America in Congress assembled,*

3 **SECTION 1. PERMANENT RESIDENT STATUS FOR SHING MA**

4 **“STEVE” LI.**

5 (a) IN GENERAL.—Notwithstanding any other provi-
6 sion of law or any order, for purposes of the Immigration
7 and Nationality Act (8 U.S.C. 1101 et seq.), Shing Ma
8 “Steve” Li shall be—

9 (1) deemed to have been lawfully admitted to,
10 and remained in, the United States; and

1 (2) eligible for issuance of an immigrant visa or
2 for adjustment of status under section 245 of such
3 Act (8 U.S.C. 1255).

4 (b) APPLICATION AND PAYMENT OF FEES.—Sub-
5 section (a) shall apply only if the applications for issuance
6 of an immigrant visa or for adjustment of status are filed,
7 with appropriate fees, not later than 2 years after the date
8 of the enactment of this Act.

9 (c) REDUCTION OF IMMIGRANT VISA NUMBERS.—
10 Upon the granting of an immigrant visa to Shing Ma
11 “Steve” Li, the Secretary of State shall instruct the prop-
12 er officer to reduce by 1, during the current or next fol-
13 lowing fiscal year, the total number of immigrant visas
14 that are made available to natives of the country of the
15 birth of Shing Ma “Steve” Li under—

16 (1) section 203(a) of the Immigration and Na-
17 tionality Act (8 U.S.C. 1153(a)); or

18 (2) section 202(e) of such Act (8 U.S.C.
19 1152(e)), if applicable.

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
