To provide Internet access to certain Congressional Research Service publications.

 SECTION 1. PUBLIC AVAILABILITY OF INFORMATION.
 The Sergeant-at-Arms of the Senate shall make in formation available to the public in accordance with the
 provisions of this resolution.
 SEC. 2. AVAILABILITY OF CERTAIN CONGRESSIONAL RE-

13 SEC. 3. METHOD OF ACCESS.

- 14 (a) CRS Information.—Public access to Congres-15 sional Research Service information made available under section 2 shall be provided through the websites main-16 tained by Members and Committees of the Senate. The Sergeant-at-Arms shall ensure that the websites main-18 tained by Members and Committees of the Senate provide 19 the same capability to find information made available 21 under section 2 as the Congressional Research Service 22 website.
- (b) Editorial Responsibility for CRS Reports
 Online.—The Sergeant-at-Arms of the Senate is respon-

- 1 sible for maintaining and updating the information made
- 2 available on the Internet under section 2.
- 3 SEC. 4. IMPLEMENTATION.
- 4 The Sergeant-at-Arms of the Senate shall establish
- 5 the database described in section 2(a) within 6 months
- 6 after the date of adoption of this resolution.
