Mr. MCCONNELL (for himself and Mr. REID) submitted the following resolution; which was considered and agree to

RESOLUTION

To provide funding for Senate staff transition.

Resolved, That (a) for purposes of this section, the
 term "eligible staff member" means an individual—

3 (1) whose pay is disbursed by the Secretary of
4 the Senate and was an employee as of January 2,
5 2009; and

6 (2) who was an employee of a Senator who
7 stood for an additional term for the office of Senator
8 but the office is not filled at the commencement of
9 that term.

(b)(1) With respect to an eligible staff member who
is being treated as a displaced staff member under section
6 of Senate Resolution 458 (98th Congress), as amended

by Senate Resolution 9 (103d Congress), the period re ferred to in section 6(c)(1) of such resolution shall be 90
 days.

4 (2)(A) Each eligible staff member may, with the ap5 proval, direction, and supervision of the Secretary of the
6 Senate, perform limited duties such as archiving and
7 transferring case files.

8 (B) The Secretary of the Senate may hire 2 addi-9 tional eligible staff members to perform the duties de-10 scribed in subparagraph (A) subject to subparagraph (C). Such employees shall be treated as displaced staff mem-11 bers under section 6 of Senate Resolution 458 (98th Con-12 13 gress), as amended by Senate Resolution 9 (103d Congress), after the expiration of the period described in sub-14 15 paragraph (C). Expenses for such employees shall be paid from the Contingent Fund of the Senate. 16

17 (C) Subparagraph (A) shall apply for the period from
18 January 2, 2009 through February 4, 2009 unless the eli19 gible staff member becomes otherwise employed.

(3) A statement in writing by an eligible staff member that he or she was not gainfully employed during such
period or the portion thereof for which payment is claimed
under this subsection shall be accepted as prima facie evidence that he or she was not so employed.

(c) The Secretary of the Senate shall notify the Com mittee on Rules and Administration of the name of each
 eligible staff member.

4 (d)(1) During the period described in paragraph (2), 5 the official office and State office expenses relating to archiving and transferring case files of a Senator who 6 7 stood for an additional term for the office of Senator but 8 whose office is not filled at the commencement of that 9 term shall be paid from the account for Miscellaneous 10 Items within the contingent fund of the Senate upon 11 vouchers approved and obligated by the Secretary of the 12 Senate or the Sergeant at Arms and Doorkeeper of the 13 Senate, as appropriate.

14 (2) The period described in paragraph (1) is the pe-15 riod from January 2, 2009 through February 4, 2009.

(e) Except as provided in subsection (b)(2)(B), funds
necessary to carry out the provisions of this section shall
be available as set forth in section 1(d) of Senate Resolution 458, agreed to October 4, 1984 (98th Congress).

20 (f) This section shall expire 90 days after January21 3, 2009.

SEC. 2. (a) For purposes of section 6(a)(4)(A)(i) of
Senate Resolution 458 (98th Congress), as amended by
Senate Resolution 9 (103d Congress), the term committee
shall include subcommittee.
