Mr. REID (for himself and Mr. McCONNELL) submitted the following resolution; which was considered and agreed to

---

## RESOLUTION

To provide for issuance of a summons and for related procedures concerning the articles of impeachment against Samuel B. Kent.

1       *Resolved*, That a summons shall be issued which com-  
2 mands Samuel B. Kent to file with the Secretary of the  
3 Senate an answer to the articles of impeachment no later  
4 than July 2, 2009, and thereafter to abide by, obey, and  
5 perform such orders, directions, and judgments as the  
6 Senate shall make in the premises, according to the Con-  
7 stitution and laws of the United States.

8       SEC. 2. The Sergeant at Arms is authorized to utilize  
9 the services of the Deputy Sergeant at Arms or another  
10 employee of the Senate in serving the summons.

1        SEC. 3. The Secretary shall notify the House of Rep-  
2        resentatives of the filing of the answer and shall provide  
3        a copy of the answer to the House.

4        SEC. 4. The Managers on the part of the House may  
5        file with the Secretary of the Senate a replication no later  
6        than July 7, 2009.

7        SEC. 5. The Secretary shall notify counsel for Samuel  
8        B. Kent of the filing of a replication, and shall provide  
9        counsel with a copy.

10       SEC. 6. The Secretary shall provide the answer and  
11       the replication, if any, to the Presiding Officer of the Sen-  
12       ate on the first day the Senate is in session after the Sec-  
13       retary receives them, and the Presiding Officer shall cause  
14       the answer and replication, if any, to be printed in the  
15       Senate Journal and in the Congressional Record. If a  
16       timely answer has not been filed, the Presiding Officer  
17       shall cause a plea of not guilty to be entered.

18       SEC. 7. The articles of impeachment, the answer, and  
19       the replication, if any, together with the provisions of the  
20       Constitution on impeachment, and the Rules of Procedure  
21       and Practice in the Senate When Sitting on Impeachment  
22       Trials, shall be printed under the direction of the Sec-  
23       retary as a Senate document.

24       SEC. 8. The provisions of this resolution shall govern  
25       notwithstanding any provisions to the contrary in the

1 Rules of Procedure and Practice in the Senate When Sit-  
2 ting on Impeachment Trials.

3       SEC. 9. The Secretary shall notify the House of Rep-  
4 resentatives of this resolution.
