## RESOLUTION

To permit the collection of clothing, toys, food, and housewares during the holiday season for charitable purposes in Senate buildings.

1       *Resolved,*

2       **SECTION 1. COLLECTION OF CLOTHING, TOYS, FOOD, AND**

3                       **HOUSEWARES DURING THE HOLIDAY SEASON**

4                       **FOR CHARITABLE PURPOSES IN SENATE**

5                       **BUILDINGS.**

6           (a) IN GENERAL.—Notwithstanding any other provi-  
7 sion of the rules or regulations of the Senate—

8                       (1) a Senator, officer, or employee of the Sen-

9                       ate may collect from another Senator, officer, or em-

10                      ployee of the Senate within Senate buildings non-

1 monetary donations of clothing, toys, food, and  
2 housewares for charitable purposes related to serving  
3 those in need or members of the Armed Services and  
4 their families during the holiday season, if such pur-  
5 poses do not otherwise violate any rule or regulation  
6 of the Senate or of Federal law; and

7 (2) a Senator, officer, or employee of the Sen-  
8 ate may work with a nonprofit organization with re-  
9 spect to the delivery of donations described in para-  
10 graph (1).

11 (b) EXPIRATION.—The authority provided by this  
12 resolution shall expire at the end of the 1st session of the  
13 111th Congress.
