Mr. HARPER submitted the following concurrent resolution; which was referred to the Committee on House Administration

CONCURRENT RESOLUTION

Authorizing the printing of the 25th edition of the pocket version of the United States Constitution.

1 *Resolved by the House of Representatives (the Senate*
2 *concurring),*

3 **SECTION 1. POCKET VERSION OF THE UNITED STATES**
4 **CONSTITUTION.**

5 (a) IN GENERAL.—The 25th edition of the pocket
6 version of the United States Constitution shall be printed
7 as a House document under the direction of the Joint
8 Committee on Printing.

9 (b) ADDITIONAL COPIES.—In addition to the usual
10 number, there shall be printed the lesser of—

1 (1) 235,500 copies of the document, of which
2 220,500 copies shall be for the use of the House of
3 Representatives, 10,000 copies shall be for the use
4 of the Senate, and 5,000 copies shall be for the use
5 of the Joint Committee on Printing; or

6 (2) such number of copies of the document as
7 does not exceed a total production and printing cost
8 of \$114,849, with distribution to be allocated in the
9 same proportion as described in paragraph (1), ex-
10 cept that in no case shall the number of copies be
11 less than 1 per Member of Congress.

12 (c) DISTRIBUTION.—The copies of the document
13 printed for the use of the House and the Senate under
14 subsection (a) shall be distributed in accordance with—

15 (1) a distribution plan approved by the chair
16 and ranking minority member of the Committee on
17 House Administration of the House of Representa-
18 tives, in the case of the copies printed for the use
19 of the House; and

20 (2) a distribution plan approved by the chair
21 and ranking minority member of the Committee on
22 Rules and Administration of the Senate, in the case
23 of the copies printed for the use of the Senate.
