A BILL

To amend the Public Health Service Act to provide for the participation of physical therapists in the National Health Service Corps Loan Repayment Program, and for other purposes.

2 *tives of the United States of America in Congress assembled,*

3 **SECTION 1. SHORT TITLE.**

4 This Act may be cited as the “Physical Therapist
5 Student Loan Repayment Eligibility Act of 2011”.

1 **SEC. 2. NATIONAL HEALTH SERVICE CORPS; PARTICIPA-**
2 **TION OF PHYSICAL THERAPISTS IN LOAN RE-**
3 **PAYMENT PROGRAM.**

4 (a) MISSION OF CORPS; DEFINITION OF PRIMARY
5 HEALTH SERVICES.—Section 331(a)(3)(D) of the Public
6 Health Service Act (42 U.S.C. 254d(a)(3)(D)) is amended
7 by striking “or mental health,” and inserting “mental
8 health, or physical therapy,”.

9 (b) LOAN REPAYMENT PROGRAM.—Section 338B of
10 the Public Health Service Act (42 U.S.C. 254l–1) is
11 amended—

12 (1) in subsection (a)(1), by striking “and physi-
13 cian assistants;” and inserting “physician assistants,
14 and physical therapists;”; and

15 (2) in subsection (b)(1)—

16 (A) in subparagraph (A), by inserting be-
17 fore the semicolon the following: “, or have a
18 doctoral or master’s degree in physical ther-
19 apy”;

20 (B) in subparagraph (B), by inserting
21 “physical therapy,” after “mental health;” and

22 (C) in subparagraph (C)(ii), by inserting
23 “physical therapy,” after “dentistry,”.
