- 7 168(e)(3)(B) of the Internal Revenue Code of 1986 is
- 8 amended by striking ", and which is placed in service be-
- 9 fore January 1, 2010".

- 1 (b) Effective Date.—The amendment made by
- 2 this section shall apply to property placed in service after

3 December 31, 2009.

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
