A BILL

To amend the Endangered Species Act of 1973 to provide
that Bluefin tuna may not be treated as an endangered
species or threatened species.

1 *Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representa-*
2 *tives of the United States of America in Congress assembled,*

3 **SECTION 1. SHORT TITLE.**

4 This Act may be cited as the “Bluefin Tuna Fisher-
5 men Employment Preservation Act”.

1 **SEC. 2. PROHIBITING TREATMENT OF BLUEFIN TUNA AS**
2 **AN ENDANGERED SPECIES OR THREATENED**
3 **SPECIES.**

4 Section 4(a) of the Endangered Species Act of 1973
5 is amended by adding at the end the following new para-
6 graph:

7 “(4) The Bluefin tuna may not be treated as an
8 endangered species or threatened species under this
9 Act.”.

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
