1 Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representa-

2 tives of the United States of America in Congress assembled,

3 SECTION 1. REINSTATEMENT OF PENALTIES FOR CHARG-

4 ING VETERANS UNAUTHORIZED FEES.

5 (a) IN GENERAL.—Section 5905 of title 38, United

6 States Code, is amended to read as follows:

1 "§ 5905. Penalty for certain acts

2 "Except as provided in section 5904 or 1984 of this
3 title, whoever commits any of the following acts shall be
4 fined as provided in title 18, or imprisoned for not more
5 than one year, or both:

6 "(1) In connection with a proceeding before the 7 Department, the act of soliciting, contracting for, 8 charging, or receiving, or attempting to solicit, con-9 tract for, charge, or receive, any fee or compensation 10 in connection for—

11 "(A) the provision of advice on how to file
12 a claim for benefits under the laws adminis13 tered by the Secretary; or

14 "(B) the preparation, presentation, or
15 prosecution of such a claim before the date on
16 which a notice of disagreement is filed in a pro17 ceeding on the claim.

"(2) The act of unlawfully withholding from
any claimant or beneficiary any part of a benefit or
claim under the laws administered by the Secretary
that is allowed and due to the claimant or beneficiary.".

(b) EFFECTIVE DATE.—The amendment made by
subsection (a) shall apply with respect to acts committed
after the date of the enactment of this Act.
