## AN ACT

To direct the Secretary of the Interior to install in the area of the World War II Memorial in the District of Columbia a suitable plaque or an inscription with the words that President Franklin D. Roosevelt prayed with the Nation on June 6, 1944, the morning of D-Day.

1	Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representa-
2	tives of the United States of America in Congress assembled,
3	SECTION 1. SHORT TITLE.
4	This Act may be cited as the "World War II Memo-
5	rial Prayer Act of 2012".
6	SEC. 2. PLACEMENT OF PLAQUE OR INSCRIPTION AT
7	WORLD WAR II MEMORIAL.
8	The Secretary of the Interior—
9	(1) shall install in the area of the World War
10	II Memorial in the District of Columbia a suitable
11	plaque or an inscription with the words that Presi-
12	dent Franklin D. Roosevelt prayed with the Nation
13	on June 6, 1944, the morning of D-Day;
14	(2) shall design, procure, prepare, and install
15	the plaque or inscription referred to in paragraph
16	(1); and
17	(3) may not use Federal funds to prepare or in-
18	stall the plaque or inscription referred to in para-
19	graph (1), but may accept and expend private con-
20	tributions for this purpose.

## 1 SEC. 3. COMMEMORATIVE WORKS ACT.

2 Chapter 89 of title 40, United States Code, (com3 monly known as the "Commemorative Works Act") shall
4 not apply to this Act.
