A BILL

To remove restrictions from a parcel of land situated in the Atlantic District, Accomack County, Virginia.

1 Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representa-

2 tives of the United States of America in Congress assembled,

3 SECTION 1. REMOVAL OF RESTRICTIONS.

4 (a) REMOVAL.—The Secretary of the Interior shall
5 execute such instruments as may be necessary to remove
6 all deed restrictions described in subsection (b) relating
7 to the parcel of land described in subsection (c).

8 (b) DEED RESTRICTIONS.—The deed restrictions re9 ferred to in subsection (a) are those restrictions, including
10 easements, exceptions, reservations, terms, conditions, and

covenants described in Quitclaim Deed No. 17808A from
 the United States to Accomack County, Virginia, executed
 on December 20, 1976, and recorded among the real es tate records of Accomack County, Virginia, by the Clerk
 of the Circuit Court, on pages 292 through 296 of Deed
 Book 381.

7 (c) DESCRIPTION OF LAND.—The parcel of land re8 ferred to in subsection (a) consists of approximately 31.6
9 acres situated in the Atlantic District, Accomack County,
10 Virginia, more particularly described in the metes and
11 bounds description recorded on page 292 of the quitclaim
12 deed described in subsection (b).
