Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representa tives of the United States of America in Congress assembled,

#### **3** SECTION 1. SHORT TITLE.

4 This Act may be cited as the "SOAR Technical Cor5 rections Act".

#### 6 SEC. 2. USE OF FUNDS.

Section 3008(h) of the Scholarships for Opportunity
and Results Act (Public Law 112–10; 125 Stat. 205) is
amended by striking paragraphs (1) and (2) and inserting
the following:

21 <u>"(1) IN GENERAL.</u>—The Institute of Education
22 Sciences shall administer nationally norm-referenced
23 standardized tests, as described in paragraph (3)(A)
24 of section 3009(a), to students participating in the
25 evaluation under section 3009(a) for the purpose of

conducting the evaluation under such section, except
 where a student is attending a participating school
 that is administering the same nationally norm-ref erenced standardized test.

 $\frac{((2)}{(2)}$ 5 TEST **RESULTS.**—Each participating 6 school that administers the nationally norm-ref-7 erenced standardized test described in paragraph (1) 8 to an eligible student shall make the test results, 9 with respect to such student, available to the See-10 retary as necessary for evaluation under section <del>3009(a).".</del> 11
