3 SECTION 1. YOSEMITE NATIONAL PARK LAND ACQUISI-4 TION.

5 (a) ACQUISITION.—The Secretary of the Interior may
6 acquire not more than 18 acres of land and interests in
7 land near the junction of highways CA-49 and CA-140
8 in Mariposa, California.

(b) PROHIBITION ON ACQUISITION BY EMINENT DO MAIN.—The Secretary may not acquire property under
 this section by eminent domain.

4 (c) Planning and Administration.—The Sec-5 retary—

6 (1) shall administer land or interests in land ac7 quired under this section as part of Yosemite Na8 tional Park in accordance with applicable laws and
9 regulations; and

10 (2) may partner with Mariposa County regard11 ing land use planning related to land and interests
12 in land acquired under this section.
