To amend the Food and Nutrition Act of 2008 to repeal the authority to make performance-based bonus payments to States.

1 *Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representa-*
2 *tives of the United States of America in Congress assembled,*

3 **SECTION 1. SHORT TITLE.**

4 This Act may be cited as the “Stopping Needless Ad-
5 ditional Performance Bonuses (SNAP) Act of 2011”.

6 **SEC. 2. AMENDMENTS.**

7 (a) REPEALER.—Section 16 of the Food and Nutri-
8 tion Act of 2008 (7 U.S.C. 2025) is amended by striking
9 subsection (d).

1 (b) CONFORMING AMENDMENTS.—Section 16(c) of
2 the Food and Nutrition Act of 2008 (7 U.S.C. 2025(e))
3 is amended—

4 (1) in the first sentence of paragraph (4) by
5 striking “, or performance under the performance
6 measures under subsection (d)”, and

7 (2) in the first sentence of paragraph (5) by
8 striking “, or performance under the performance
9 measures under subsection (d)”.
