#### MERCIAL DRIVER'S LICENSES.

9 (a) ESTABLISHMENT.—Not later than 1 year after10 the date of enactment of this Act, the Secretary of Trans-

portation, in consultation with the Secretary of Defense
 and in cooperation with the States, shall establish acceler ated licensing procedures to assist veterans to acquire
 commercial driver's licenses.

5 (b) ACCELERATED LICENSING PROCEDURES.—The
6 procedures established under subsection (a) shall be de7 signed to be applicable to any veteran who—

8 (1) is attempting to acquire a commercial driv-9 er's license; and

(2) obtained, during military service, driving experience that, in the determination of the Secretary,
makes the use of accelerated licensing procedures
appropriate.

14 (c) DEFINITIONS.—In this section, the following defi-15 nitions apply:

16 (1) COMMERCIAL DRIVER'S LICENSE.—The
17 term "commercial driver's license" has the meaning
18 given that term in section 31301(3) of title 49,
19 United States Code.

20 (2) STATE.—The term "State" has the mean21 ing given that term in section 31301(13) of title 49,
22 United States Code.

(3) VETERAN.—The term "veteran" has the
 meaning given that term in section 101(2) of title
 38, United States Code.
