7 411(h)(2) of the Surface Mining Control and Reclamation
8 Act of 1977 (30 U.S.C. 1240a(h)(2)) is amended to read
9 as follows:

1	"(2) LIMITATION.—No payment shall be made
2	under this subsection to a State or Indian tribe for
3	which a certification is made under subsection (a) in
4	which the Secretary concurs.".
5	(b) Conforming Amendments.—Such Act is fur-
6	ther amended—
7	(1) in section $402(i)(2)$ (30 U.S.C. $1232(i)(2)$),
8	by striking "paragraphs $(1)(A)$ and $(2)(A)$ " and in-
9	serting "paragraph (1)(A)"; and
10	(2) by amending section $411(h)(1)(D)$ (30)
11	U.S.C. $1240a(h)(1)(D)$) to read as follows:
12	"(D) USE OF FUNDS.—A State or Indian
