6	Section 3704(a) of title 28, United States Code, is

11	the end and inserting "; or"; and
12	(3) by adding at the end the following:
13	((5) a lottery, sweepstakes, or other betting,
14	gambling, or waging scheme operating exclusively in
15	the State of New Jersey, to the extent such scheme
16	is approved by the legislature of the State by stat-
17	ute.".
18	SEC. 3. APPLICABILITY.
