To restrict the provision of defense articles and defense services to the Government of Iraq, and for other purposes.

- 1 Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representa-
- 2 tives of the United States of America in Congress assembled,
- 3 SECTION 1. RESTRICTIONS ON PROVISION OF DEFENSE AR-
- 4 TICLES AND DEFENSE SERVICES TO THE
- 5 GOVERNMENT OF IRAQ.
- 6 (a) Restriction.—No defense articles or defense
- 7 services may be provided to the Government of Iraq unless
- 8 the President certifies to Congress that the Government
- 9 of Iraq agrees that it will not use such defense articles
- 10 or defense services or any other defense articles of defense

4	(b) Additional Restrictions.—If the President
5	determines that Iraq has used defense articles or defense
6	services in violation of the requirements of subsection (a),
7	no further defense articles or defense services may be pro-
8	vided to the Government of Iraq unless the President cer-
9	tifies to Congress that—
10	(1) the Government of Iraq has withdrawn the
11	defense articles or defense services from Kurdistan
12	and the Kurdistan Regional Government has con-
13	firmed the withdrawal of the defense articles or de-
14	fense services; and
15	(2) the Kurdistan Regional Government has ap-
16	proved the provision to the Government of Iraq of
17	such further defense articles or defense services.
18	(c) Definitions.—In this section—
19	(1) the term "defense article" has the meaning
20	given the term in section 47(3) of the Arms Export
21	Control Act; and
22	(2) the term "defense service" has the meaning
