To amend the Reclamation Wastewater and Groundwater Study and Facilities Act to expand the Bay Area Regional Water Recycling Program, and for other purposes.

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## A BILL

To amend the Reclamation Wastewater and Groundwater Study and Facilities Act to expand the Bay Area Regional Water Recycling Program, and for other purposes.

1 *Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representa-*  
2 *tives of the United States of America in Congress assembled,*

3 **SECTION 1. SHORT TITLE.**

4 This Act may be cited as the “Bay Area Regional  
5 Water Recycling Program Expansion Act of 2012”.

6 **SEC. 2. PROJECT AUTHORIZATIONS.**

7 (a) IN GENERAL.—The Reclamation Wastewater and  
8 Groundwater Study and Facilities Act (Public Law 102–

1 575, title XVI; 43 U.S.C. 390h et seq.) is amended by  
2 adding at the end the following:

3 **“SEC. 1657. CCCSD-CONCORD RECYCLED WATER PROJECT.**

4 “(a) AUTHORIZATION.—The Secretary, in coopera-  
5 tion with the Central Contra Costa Sanitary District, Cali-  
6 fornia, is authorized to participate in the design, planning,  
7 and construction of recycled water system facilities.

8 “(b) COST SHARE.—The Federal share of the cost  
9 of the project authorized by this section shall not exceed  
10 25 percent of the total cost of the project.

11 “(c) LIMITATION.—The Secretary shall not provide  
12 funds for the operation and maintenance of the project  
13 authorized by this section.

14 “(d) AUTHORIZATION OF APPROPRIATIONS.—There  
15 is authorized to be appropriated to carry out this section  
16 \$1,800,000.

17 **“SEC. 1658. CENTRAL DUBLIN RECYCLED WATER DISTRIBU-**  
18 **TION AND RETROFIT PROJECT.**

19 “(a) AUTHORIZATION.—The Secretary, in coopera-  
20 tion with the Dublin San Ramon Services District, Cali-  
21 fornia, is authorized to participate in the design, planning,  
22 and construction of recycled water system facilities.

23 “(b) COST SHARE.—The Federal share of the cost  
24 of the project authorized by this section shall not exceed  
25 25 percent of the total cost of the project.

1 “(c) LIMITATION.—The Secretary shall not provide  
2 funds for the operation and maintenance of the project  
3 authorized by this section.

4 “(d) AUTHORIZATION OF APPROPRIATIONS.—There  
5 is authorized to be appropriated to carry out this section  
6 \$1,150,000.

7 **“SEC. 1659. CENTRAL REDWOOD CITY RECYCLED WATER**  
8 **PROJECT.**

9 “(a) AUTHORIZATION.—The Secretary, in coopera-  
10 tion with the City of Redwood City, California, is author-  
11 ized to participate in the design, planning, and construc-  
12 tion of recycled water system facilities.

13 “(b) COST SHARE.—The Federal share of the cost  
14 of the project authorized by this section shall not exceed  
15 25 percent of the total cost of the project.

16 “(c) LIMITATION.—The Secretary shall not provide  
17 funds for the operation and maintenance of the project  
18 authorized by this section.

19 “(d) AUTHORIZATION OF APPROPRIATIONS.—There  
20 is authorized to be appropriated to carry out this section  
21 \$8,000,000.

22 **“SEC. 1660. PALO ALTO RECYCLED WATER PIPELINE**  
23 **PROJECT.**

24 “(a) AUTHORIZATION.—The Secretary, in coopera-  
25 tion with the City of Palo Alto, California, is authorized

1 to participate in the design, planning, and construction of  
2 recycled water system facilities.

3 “(b) COST SHARE.—The Federal share of the cost  
4 of the project authorized by this section shall not exceed  
5 25 percent of the total cost of the project.

6 “(c) LIMITATION.—The Secretary shall not provide  
7 funds for the operation and maintenance of the project  
8 authorized by this section.

9 “(d) AUTHORIZATION OF APPROPRIATIONS.—There  
10 is authorized to be appropriated to carry out this section  
11 \$8,250,000.

12 **“SEC. 1661. IRONHOUSE SANITARY DISTRICT (ISD) RECY-**  
13 **CLED WATER PROJECT.**

14 “(a) AUTHORIZATION.—The Secretary, in coopera-  
15 tion with the Ironhouse Sanitary District (ISD), Cali-  
16 fornia, is authorized to participate in the design, planning,  
17 and construction of recycled water distribution systems.

18 “(b) COST SHARE.—The Federal share of the cost  
19 of the project authorized by this section shall not exceed  
20 25 percent of the total cost of the project.

21 “(c) LIMITATION.—The Secretary shall not provide  
22 funds for the operation and maintenance of the project  
23 authorized by this section.

13 tion with the Dublin San Ramon Services District, Cali-  
14 fornia, is authorized to participate in the design, planning,  
15 and construction of recycled water system facilities.

16       “(b) COST SHARE.—The Federal share of the cost  
17 of the project authorized by this section shall not exceed  
18 25 percent of the total cost of the project.

19       “(c) LIMITATION.—The Secretary shall not provide  
20 funds for the operation and maintenance of the project  
21 authorized by this section.

22       “(d) AUTHORIZATION OF APPROPRIATIONS.—There  
23 is authorized to be appropriated to carry out this section  
24 \$6,000,000.

1 **“SEC. 1665. HAYWARD RECYCLED WATER PROJECT.**

2       “(a) AUTHORIZATION.—The Secretary, in coopera-  
3 tion with the City of Hayward, California, is authorized  
4 to participate in the design, planning, and construction of  
5 recycled water system facilities.

6       “(b) COST SHARE.—The Federal share of the cost  
7 of the project authorized by this section shall not exceed  
8 25 percent of the total cost of the project.

9       “(c) LIMITATION.—The Secretary shall not provide  
10 funds for the operation and maintenance of the project  
11 authorized by this section.

12       “(d) AUTHORIZATION OF APPROPRIATIONS.—There  
13 is authorized to be appropriated to carry out this section  
14 \$6,750,000.

15 **“SEC. 1666. MOUNTAIN VIEW RECYCLED WATER PROJECT.**

16       “(a) AUTHORIZATION.—The Secretary, in coopera-  
17 tion with the City of Mountain View, California, is author-  
18 ized to participate in the design, planning, and construc-  
19 tion of recycled water system facilities.

20       “(b) COST SHARE.—The Federal share of the cost  
21 of the project authorized by this section shall not exceed  
22 25 percent of the total cost of the project.

23       “(c) LIMITATION.—The Secretary shall not provide  
24 funds for the operation and maintenance of the project  
25 authorized by this section.

11       “(a) AUTHORIZATION.—The Secretary, in coopera-  
12 tion with the Town of Yountville, California, is authorized  
13 to participate in the design, planning, and construction of  
14 recycled water system facilities.

15       “(b) COST SHARE.—The Federal share of the cost  
16 of the project authorized by this section shall not exceed  
17 25 percent of the total cost of the project.

18       “(c) LIMITATION.—The Secretary shall not provide  
19 funds for the operation and maintenance of the project  
20 authorized by this section.

21       “(d) AUTHORIZATION OF APPROPRIATIONS.—There  
22 is authorized to be appropriated to carry out this section  
23 \$1,100,000.”.

24       (b) PROJECT IMPLEMENTATION.—In carrying out  
25 sections 1642 through 1656 of the Reclamation Waste-

1 water and Groundwater Study and Facilities Act, and the  
2 sections added to such Act under subsection (a), the Sec-  
3 retary shall enter into individual agreements with the San  
4 Francisco Bay Area Recycled Water Coalition partici-  
5 pating agencies to fund the projects and may include in  
6 such agreements a provision for the reimbursement of con-  
7 struction costs, including those construction costs incurred  
8 prior to the enactment of this Act, subject to appropria-  
9 tions made available for the Federal share of the project  
10 under sections 1642 through 1656 of the Reclamation  
11 Wastewater and Groundwater Study and Facilities Act  
12 and the sections added to such Act under subsection (a).

13 (c) CLERICAL AMENDMENTS.—The table of sections  
14 of section 2 of the Reclamation Projects Authorization and  
15 Adjustment Act of 1992 (43 U.S.C. prec. 371) is amended  
16 by inserting after the item relating to section 1656 the  
17 following:

“Sec. 1657. CCCSD-concord recycled water project.

“Sec. 1658. Central Dublin recycled water distribution and retrofit project.

“Sec. 1659. Central Redwood City recycled water project.

“Sec. 1660. Palo Alto recycled water pipeline project.

“Sec. 1661. Ironhouse Sanitary District (ISD) recycled water project.

“Sec. 1662. Contra Costa County Refinery recycled water project, phase 1.

“Sec. 1663. Delta Diablo Sanitation District recycled water advanced treatment  
and expansion project.

“Sec. 1664. Dublin recycled water expansion project.

“Sec. 1665. Hayward recycled water project.

“Sec. 1666. Mountain View recycled water project.

“Sec. 1667. Pleasanton recycled water project.

“Sec. 1668. San Jose Water Company recycled water project.

“Sec. 1669. Yountville recycled water project.”.

1 **SEC. 3. MODIFICATION TO AUTHORIZED PROJECTS.**

2 (a) ANTIOCH RECYCLED WATER PROJECT.—Section  
3 1644(d) of the Reclamation Wastewater and Groundwater  
4 Study and Facilities Act (43 U.S.C. 390h–27) is amended  
5 by striking “\$2,250,000” and inserting “\$3,200,000”.

6 (b) SOUTH BAY ADVANCED RECYCLED WATER  
7 TREATMENT FACILITY.—Section 1648(d) of the Reclama-  
8 tion Wastewater and Groundwater Study and Facilities  
9 Act (43 U.S.C. 390h–31) is amended by striking  
10 “\$8,250,000” and inserting “\$14,750,000”.

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
