A BILL

2 *tives of the United States of America in Congress assembled,*

1 **SECTION 1. BRIGADIER GENERAL NATHANIEL WOODHULL**
2 **POST OFFICE BUILDING.**

3 (a) DESIGNATION.—The facility of the United States
4 Postal Service located at 110 Mastic Road in Mastic
5 Beach, New York, shall be known and designated as the
6 “Brigadier General Nathaniel Woodhull Post Office Build-
7 ing”.

8 (b) REFERENCES.—Any reference in a law, map, reg-
9 ulation, document, paper, or other record of the United
10 States to the facility referred to in subsection (a) shall
11 be deemed to be a reference to the “Brigadier General
12 Nathaniel Woodhull Post Office Building”.
