## A BILL

To amend the Food, Conservation, and Energy Act to repeal a duplicative program relating to inspection and grading of catfish.

1 *Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representa-*  
2 *tives of the United States of America in Congress assembled,*

3 **SECTION 1. REPEAL OF DUPLICATIVE CATFISH INSPEC-**  
4 **TION PROGRAM.**

5 (a) IN GENERAL.—Effective on the date of the enact-  
6 ment of the Food, Conservation, and Energy Act of 2008  
7 (7 U.S.C. 8701 et seq.), section 11016 of such Act (Public  
8 Law 110–246; 122 Stat. 2130) and the amendments made  
9 by such section are repealed.

1           (b) APPLICATION.—The Agricultural Marketing Act  
2 of 1946 (7 U.S.C. 1621 et seq.) and the Federal Meat  
3 Inspection Act (21 U.S.C. 601 et seq.) shall be applied  
4 and administered as if section 11016 (Public Law 110–  
5 246; 122 Stat. 2130) of the Food, Conservation, and En-  
6 ergy Act of 2008 (7 U.S.C. 8701 et seq.) and the amend-  
7 ments made by such section had not been enacted.
