## A BILL

To amend title 5, United States Code, to specify further conditions under which payment for the services of a recess appointee may not be made from the Treasury.

- 1 Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representa-
- 2 tives of the United States of America in Congress assembled,
- 3 SECTION 1. SHORT TITLE.
- 4 This Act may be cited as the "Recess Appointment
- 5 Restoration Act".
- 6 SEC. 2. AMENDMENT.
- 7 Section 5503 of title 5, United States Code, is
- 8 amended by adding at the end the following:

- 1 "(c)(1) Payment for services may not be made from
- 2 the Treasury of the United States to an individual ap-
- 3 pointed to fill a vacancy that is by law required to be filled
- 4 by and with the advice and consent of the Senate, until
- 5 the appointee has been confirmed by the Senate, unless
- 6 the individual was appointed while the Senate was ad-
- 7 journed for at least 10 days.
- 8 "(2) For purposes of this subsection, a day of ad-
- 9 journment of the Senate is a day on which the Senate does
- 10 not meet.".
