A BILL

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To authorize the Secretary of the Interior to issue permits for a microhydro project in nonwilderness areas within the boundaries of Denali National Park and Preserve, to acquire land for Denali National Park and Preserve from Doyon Tourism, Inc., and for other purposes.

1	Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representa-
2	tives of the United States of America in Congress assembled,
3	SECTION 1. SHORT TITLE.
4	This Act may be cited as the "Kantishna Hills Renew-
5	able Energy Act of 2011".
6	SEC. 2. DEFINITIONS.
7	In this Act:
8	(1) APPURTENANCE.—The term "appurtenance"
9	includes—
10	(A) transmission lines;
11	(B) distribution lines;
12	(C) signs;
13	(D) buried communication lines;
14	(E) necessary access routes for microhydro
15	project construction, operation, and mainte-
16	nance; and
17	(F) electric cables.
18	(2) KANTISHNA HILLS AREA.—The term
19	"Kantishna Hills area" means the area of the Park
20	located within 2 miles of Moose Creek, as depicted on
21	the map.
22	(3) MAP.—The term "map" means the map enti-
23	tled "Kantishna Hills Micro-Hydro Area", numbered
24	184/80,276, and dated August 27, 2010.
25	(4) Microhydro project.—

1	(A) IN GENERAL.—The term "microhydro
2	project" means a hydroelectric power generating
3	facility with a maximum power generation ca-
4	pability of 100 kilowatts.
5	(B) INCLUSIONS.—The term "microhydro
6	project" includes—
7	(i) intake pipelines, including the in-
8	take pipeline located on Eureka Creek, ap-
9	proximately $\frac{1}{2}$ mile upstream from the
10	Park Road, as depicted on the map;
11	(ii) each system appurtenance of the
12	microhydro projects; and
13	(iii) any distribution or transmission
14	lines required to serve the Kantishna Hills
15	area.
16	(5) PARK.—The term "Park" means the Denali
17	National Park and Preserve.
18	(6) Secretary.—The term "Secretary" means
19	the Secretary of the Interior.
20	SEC. 3. PERMITS FOR MICROHYDRO PROJECTS.
21	(a) IN GENERAL.—The Secretary may issue permits
22	for microhydro projects in the Kantishna Hills area.
23	(b) TERMS AND CONDITIONS.—Each permit under
24	subsection (a) shall be—

1 (1) issued in accordance with such terms and 2 conditions as are generally applicable to rights-of-way within units of the National Park System; and 3 4 (2) subject to such other terms and conditions as 5 the Secretary determines to be necessary. 6 (c) Completion of Environmental Analysis.—Not 7 later than 180 days after the date on which an applicant 8 submits an application for the issuance of a permit under 9 this section, the Secretary shall complete any analysis re-10 quired by the National Environment Policy Act of 1969 (42) U.S.C. 4321 et seq.) of any proposed or existing microhydro 11 projects located in the Kantishna Hills area. 12

13 SEC. 4. LAND EXCHANGE.

14 (a) IN GENERAL.—For the purpose of consolidating 15 ownership of Park and Doyon Tourism, Inc. lands, including those lands affected solely by the Doyon Tourism 16 microhydro project, and subject to subsection (d), the Sec-17 18 retary may exchange Park land near or adjacent to land owned by Doyon Tourism, Inc., located at the mouth of Eu-19 reka Creek in sec. 13, T.16 S., R. 18 W., Fairbanks Merid-20 21 ian, for approximately 18 acres of land owned by Doyon 22 Tourism, Inc., within the Galena patented mining claim. 23 (b) MAP AVAILABILITY.—The map shall be on file and

24 available for public inspection in the appropriate offices of

25 the National Park Service.

(c) TIMING.—The Secretary shall seek to complete the
 exchange under this section by not later than February 1,
 2015.

4 (d) APPLICABLE LAWS; TERMS AND CONDITIONS.—
5 The exchange under this section shall be subject to—

6 (1) the laws (including regulations) and policies
7 applicable to exchanges of land administered by the
8 National Park Service, including the laws and poli9 cies concerning land appraisals, equalization of val10 ues, and environmental compliance; and

(2) such terms and conditions as the Secretary
determines to be necessary.

(e) EQUALIZATION OF VALUES.—If the tracts proposed
for exchange under this section are determined not to be
equal in value, an equalization of values may be achieved
by adjusting the quantity of acres described in subsection
(a).

(f) ADMINISTRATION.—The land acquired by the Secretary pursuant to the exchange under this section shall be
administered as part of the Park.
