A BILL

To require the Comptroller General to conduct an annual audit of the General Services Administration.

3 SECTION 1. ANNUAL AUDIT.

4 (a) INITIAL AND ANNUAL AUDIT.—Not later than 5 120 days after the date of enactment of this Act and by 6 the end of every subsequent fiscal year thereafter, the 7 Comptroller General shall conduct an extensive audit de-8 scribed in subsection (b) of the General Services Adminis-9 tration and report such findings to the Committee on Environment and Public Works of the Senate and the Com mittee on Transportation and Infrastructure of the House
of Representatives.

4 (b) DETAILED INFORMATION.—The audit referred to 5 in subsection (a) shall include detailed information for 6 each region regarding specific administrative costs; con-7 ference spending; bonuses; travel expenses; staffing levels; 8 expenditures on buildings classified as excess, surplus, or 9 underutilized; a detailed accounting of the expenditures of the Federal Buildings Fund; and any other information 10 11 the Committee on Transportation and Infrastructure of 12 the House of Representatives, the Committee on Oversight 13 and Government Reform of the House of Representatives, 14 the Committee on Environment and Public Works of the 15 Senate, and the Committee on Homeland Security and Governmental Affairs of the Senate, may request. 16
