6 rubber basketballs) is amended—

7 (1) by striking "0.7%" and inserting "Free";8 and

9 (2) by striking "12/31/2012" and inserting
10 "12/31/2015".

(b) EFFECTIVE DATE.—The amendments made bysubsection (a) apply with respect to goods entered, or

1 withdrawn from warehouse for consumption, on or after
